RPAC is an essential program. It plays a critical role in the overall systemwide research administration infrastructure. They work closely with Associate/Assistant Vice Chancellors, C&G Directors, IRB Directors, IACUC Administrators, COI Coordinators and other research administration personnel at the campuses to keep us informed of congressional bills, changes in federal and state regulations and policies, advocate on behalf of the campuses with the federal government and other research sponsors, and negotiate master agreements with the State of California and pharmaceutical companies. In addition, they facilitate communication and collaboration across the campuses and other UC locations. RPAC also serves as the systemwide coordinator for policy development, guidance and implementation. This includes managing the Research Enterprise Management System (REMS), which all of the campuses rely upon for indirect cost exceptions and sponsor codes.
